



How a Complete Health Plan Replacement Saved a Missouri Consortium \$1.68 Million

Prior to 2021, schools within a consortium in Missouri were experiencing year-after-year double-digit premium increases under their fully insured health plan.

Deep analysis proved the promise of self-funding: By integrating the full continuum of solutions on the Vālenz Health® platform, the consortium generated greater savings from robust front-end care navigation and cost-containment solutions, reducing premium increases and improving the member experience.

Challenge

Year-after-year double-digit premium increases were unsustainable with their fully insured health plan, leading the consortium to look for a better alternative with self-funded insurance solutions.


Solution
